### What you will need:

RED HEART® Lisa: 1 ball each 00148 Navy (A), 08222 Wine Red (B), and 05668 Mid Grey Melange (C)

OR

RED HEART® Detroit: 1 ball each 00148 Navy (A), 08222 Wine Red (B), and 05668 Mid Grey Melange (C)

Circular Knitting Needles: 4 mm [US 6], one 40 cm [16"] long

Double-Pointed Needles: One set 4 mm [US 6]

Stitch marker, yarn needle

TENSION/GAUGE: 21 sts = 10 cm [4"]; 30 rows = 10 cm [4"].  
CHECK YOUR TENSION/GAUGE.

Use any size needles to obtain the tension/gauge given.

## Casual Beanie

*Knit this casual beanie that's perfect for men and women! The same hat can have many different looks depending on the shades you choose.*

Directions are for adult sized hat. Fits most.

Hat Circumference: 52 cm (20½")

### NOTE

Change to double-pointed needles when there are too few sts for the circular needle.

### Pattern Stitch

**2 x 2 Rib (multiple of 4 sts)**

**Round 1 (Right Side):** \*K2, p2; repeat from \* to end of round.

Repeat this round for 2 x 2 Rib.

### HAT

With circular needle and **A**, cast on 108 sts. Place marker for beginning of round. Join to work in rounds, being careful not to twist the sts.

### Ribbing

Work in 2 x 2 Rib for 2 rounds. Cut yarn. Change to **B**. Work in 2 x 2 Rib until piece measures 5 cm (2") from beginning.

### Body

Change to St st; knit 1 round. Cut yarn. Change to **C**. Work in St st until piece measures 19 cm (7½") from beginning.

### Shape Crown

**Round 1:** \*K10, k2tog; repeat from \* to end of round—99 sts.

**Round 2:** Knit around.

**Round 3:** \*K9, k2tog; repeat from \* to end of round—90 sts.

**Round 4:** Knit around.

**Round 5:** \*K8, k2tog; repeat from \* to end of round—81 sts.

**Round 6:** Knit around.

**Round 7:** \*K7, k2tog; repeat from \* to end of round—72 sts.

**Round 8:** Knit around

**Round 9:** \*K6, k2tog; repeat from \* to end of round—63 sts.

**Round 10:** Knit around.

**Round 11:** \*K5, k2tog; repeat from \* to end of round—54 sts.

**Round 12:** Knit around.

**Round 13:** \*K4, k2tog; repeat from \* to end of round—45 sts.

**Round 14:** Knit around.

**Round 15:** \*K3, k2tog; repeat from \* to end of round—36 sts.

**Round 16:** Knit around.

**Round 17:** \*K2, k2tog; repeat from \* to end of round—27 sts.

**Round 18:** Knit around.

**Round 19:** \*K1, k2tog; repeat from \* to end of round—18 sts.

**Round 20:** Knit around.

**Round 21:** \*K2tog; repeat from \* to end of round—9 sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Weave tail through remaining sts and pull to gather.

### FINISHING

Weave in ends.

### Abbreviations

**A, B, C** = Colour A, B, C; **cm** = centimeters; **k** = knit; **k2tog** = knit next two sts together; **mm** = millimeters; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **St st** = Stockinette stitch; \* or \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
