About the Competition (Guidelines)

1. Beanie must be in a "country" theme. This can be knitted or crocheted directly into the beanie or it can be placed on / in the beanie after completion.
2. Beanie can be either children's or adult sized.
3. Any material can be used to make the beanie.
4. Winners of the Beanie Competition will be by a "People's Choice" (decided by popular vote) and a winner decided by a panel of judges (comprising one member of the Knitters' Guild; one member of the Tocal Field Day; and one community representative). The judges' decision will be final.

How to Enter the Competition

4. A completed Registration Form must accompany each beanie entered into the competition. One completed Registration Form is to accompany one beanie. No multiple entries on one Registration Form.
5. The beanie can be hand delivered to the Maitland Knitters Guild Stand up until 10am Friday, 1 May 2015 at the Tocal Field Day.
6. The beanie can be hand delivered or posted prior to 1 May 2015 to Village Books, Shop 18, Hunter Valley Gardens Village, Broke Road, Pokolbin NSW 2320 (open 7 days 10am to 4pm), ph 02 4998 6530. All beanies sent to this address must be received by 4pm Monday, 27 April 2015.
7. All registrations close at 10am Friday, 1 May 2015.

8. Collection of beanie(s), after the competition, can take place from 2pm Sunday, 3 May 2015 at the Maitland Knitters Guild Stand at Tocal Field Days.
