Workshop Supplies

Brioche meets Double Knitting Master Class (Joyce Fisher) – Saturday all day

- 2 x balls contrasting *plain* colour. Choose cheaper yarn, because it will be used for samples only. Save your good stuff for doing the free scarf pattern you will receive.
- 2 x 5mm double pointed needles or cable needle (straight needles are no good for some of this lesson)
- An extra 5mm dpn or cable hook
- 1 x 5mm crochet hook (or smaller size if you don't have 5mm)
- Several stitch markers

Colour Work Theory (Kathryn Trippett) – Saturday morning

- A range of yarn samples in different colours (doesn't have to be the whole ball, just your leftovers from projects will be fine)
- Appropriate needles

Spinning Cotton (Liz Woods) – Saturday morning

Buttonholes (Janice Ferrett) – Saturday morning

- 1 x ball 8ply (DK) yarn in any colour
- Appropriate needles
- A few buttons

Crocheted / Knitted Necklace (Sharon Holstein) – Saturday morning

- Approximately 50gm of 8ply yarn
- 4mm-5mm hook for crochet necklace or a 4 or 4.5mm circular knitting needles with a short cable
- wool sewing needles for the ends

Modifying Patterns (Debra Kinsey) – Saturday afternoon

- Calculator
- Pencil and rubber
- Writing paper
- Tape measure

Knitted Bracelet – CANCELLED

Mini Macrame (Rebecca Muscat) – Saturday afternoon

Crochet Stranded Disc Necklace – Saturday afternoon

- This workshop requires the purchase of a kit to the cost of \$12pp. Can be purchased on the day.

Beaded Knitting (Caroline Craig) – Sunday morning

- 1 x ball 4ply (fingering) yarn
- Appropriate needles
- Size 6 seed beads (1 or 2 colours)
- 0.75 – 1.0mm crochet hook

Optional homework

- There will be two samples worked. Each sample requires you to cast on 21 stitches and work 4 rows garter stitch – keep on the needles for additional work in the workshop.

Crochet Beyond the Basics (Sara Aylett) – Sunday morning

- 200g of 8ply or 10ply yarn for completed scarf or bag
- 5mm or 6mm hook (or whatever you are comfortable with)
- Scarf is best worked in a gradient cake, but any solid or semi-solid will work fine
- Bag is best worked in single colour, but a gradient cake will be fine too

Short Rows (Krista Thompson) – Sunday morning late start: 10am

- Light coloured 8ply (DK) yarn
- 4mm needles

Homework

- Cast on 30 stitches and knit 4 rows (garter stitch).

Amigurumi Magic (Joyce Fisher) – Sunday morning

- 8ply (DK) yarn – whatever takes your fancy, but not dark, you want to see your stitches.
- 4mm crochet hook
- Stitch marker – removable, to show the end of each round
- A little bit of white and black yarn to make the eyes and nose
- Scissors, wool needle, tape measure

Please note, that stuffing will be available on the day
